

4 things to check For Fire Door Closers

1 Certification

It is recommended that a minimum **power size 3** door closer is used on a fire door and the closer is **CE marked and fire rated**.

Remove the cover or slide the trimplate to check for the CE logo and EN 1154 classification code marking.

Make sure the closer has been tested and CE marked in the position it is fitted (ALWAYS refer to manufacturer instructions).



2 Operation

Release the door from the fully open position and ensure the door closes correctly into the frame.



3 Latching

Open the door to 5 degrees or 75mm (3 inches). Check that the closer **shuts the door onto the latch**.

If necessary:
- check closing and latching speeds are correctly set.



4 Maintenance

Door closers should be checked weekly and adjustments made where necessary.
