





It's important to check that replacements are like for like, and despite claims **no other imitation fits** the fixing dimensions of the Briton 2003 and Briton 2003V Series identically.

BE WARY

- Refer to manufacturers installation instructions and check fixing positions to ensure they align with the existing holes in the door and frame
- Be mindful that drilling more holes into a fire door could compromise the integrity of the door
- Double check footprint dimensions to make sure they are exact
- Be sure to check the DOP's, UKCA and CE certificates to make sure the mounting position is covered by legal requirements
